







# Safety Recall Notice

Juratoys has issued a safety recall for four Bricolo by Janod® push toy trolley models in cooperation with the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) and Health Canada. If a user presses down on the trolleys' handles with enough force, the trolleys can present an impact hazard. Affected products are identified here:

<b>Janod Redmaster – Magnetic DIY Trolley (J06493)</b>	<b>Janod DIY – Magnetic Trolley (J06505)</b>
 A red wooden toy trolley with yellow wheels and a black front panel. It has a handle on top and various tools like a wrench and screwdriver are attached to the front panel. The word 'BRICOLO' is printed on the front panel.	 A grey wooden toy trolley with red wheels and a red handle. It has various tools attached to the front panel.
<b>Janod French Cocotte Cooker Trolley (J06544)</b>	<b>Janod Barbecue Trolley (J06523)</b>
 A red wooden toy trolley with yellow wheels and a red handle. It has a white top surface with a small stove-like area and a red front panel.	 A light blue wooden toy trolley with green wheels and a light blue handle. It has a white top surface with a small barbecue-like area and a light blue front panel.

Consumers should immediately stop using the affected trolleys and keep them out of the reach of young children until a repair kit has been installed. Consumers should contact Juratoys to receive a free repair kit. The kit includes necessary instructions and tools to add footers to the trolleys' rear axle to enhance stability.
